**AN ORDINANCE**  
**EXTENDING THE MORATORIUM ON THE ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATES  
OF OCCUPANCY FOR BUSINESSES COMMONLY KNOWN AS INTERNET  
CAFÉ'S, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bay Village declared a moratorium on businesses commonly known as Internet Café's as authorized by Ordinance No. 11-52 passed June 6, 2011; and

**WHEREAS**, there is a need for additional time to study the City's existing Ordinances, Regulations, or adopt new Ordinances relating to city regulations and the impact of State regulations, if any, to be adopted, and the determination of proper zoning classification on businesses commonly known as Internet Café's;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That Council hereby extends a moratorium through June 30, 2013, on businesses commonly known as Internet Café's under C.O. 723, effective date of passage of this ordinance, in order to allow sufficient time for proper review by the City Council, Planning Commission, and any committee appointed by City Council and for consideration of state regulations, if any, to be adopted, and the determination of proper zoning classifications.

**SECTION 2.** That the Clerk of Council is hereby directed to forward a copy of this legislation to the Building Director, the Planning Commission, and any committee appointed by City Council.

**SECTION 3.** That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.

**SECTION 4.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reasons that it is necessary to protect the planning process, wherefore this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
