AN ORDINANCE
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH DIGITAL SECURITY SYSTEMS FOR THE NEW FIRE ALARM SYSTEM AT CAHOON PARK COMMUNITY HOUSE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Bay Village advertised and received competitive bids on January 24th, 2013 for the new Fire Alarm System at Cahoon Park Community House; and

WHEREAS, the lowest and best bid was determined to be the bid submitted by Digital Security Systems, Inc.;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and she is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Digital Security Systems, 15026 Madison Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio, for the new Fire Alarm System at Cahoon Park Community House, in accordance with plans and specifications, it being hereby determined that the proposal of said company is the lowest and best bid received after advertising for bids as required by law. The total bid price for said Fire Alarm System is Seventeen Thousand One Hundred Fifty-Seven and 85/100 Dollars (\$17,157.85). Payment shall be made from the Public Improvement Fund (490.790.55330).

SECTION 2. That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to proceed with the new Fire Alarm System at the Community House, wherefore this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
