A RESOLUTION
**AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN OFFICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES
(OCIS) SPECIAL SOLICITATION GRANT – LAW ENFORCEMENT APPLICATION,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City of Bay Village was advised that funds were available for a OCIS ARRA JAG Justice Assistance Special Solicitation Grant, a grant that provides funds for law enforcement agencies to attend training and to purchase law enforcement vehicles for use in performing investigations and law enforcement duties; and

WHEREAS, projects may request a maximum of \$30,000 of funding, and there is no cash matching requirement; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department would like to apply for \$28,000 for a 2013 Ford Utility Police Interceptor to be used for basic patrol, and \$2,000 for police training; and

WHEREAS, the deadline for this OCIS ARRA JAG Special Solicitation Grant application is February 28th, 2013;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That this Council hereby authorizes the application for and if awarded, to enter into an Agreement with the Office of Criminal Justice Services to administer the ARRA JAG – Special Solicitation Grant – Law Enforcement, and that the Mayor is authorized to sign said agreement.

SECTION 2. That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.

SECTION 3. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is necessary to authorize the filing of said application in a timely manner, wherefore this resolution shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
