A RESOLUTION
**AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A 2013-2014 DRUG ABUSE RESISTANCE
EDUCATION (DARE) LAW ENFORCEMENT GRANT APPLICATION,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City of Bay Village was advised that funds were available for DARE Grants Program which provide matching funds to defray the cost of an officer's base salary up to 50% (excluding fringe benefits); and

WHEREAS, the Police Division has prepared the application for submission with the Office of Ohio Attorney General, Dare Grants Administration Program;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio;

SECTION 1. That this Council hereby authorizes the application for a 2013-2014 DRUG ABUSE RESISTANCE EDUCATION (DARE) LAW ENFORCEMENT GRANT to defray the cost of the base salary of a certified DARE officer teaching the DARE curriculum in local schools in the City of Bay Village.

SECTION 2. That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.


