AN ORDINANCE
**AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH CT
CONSULTANTS, INC. FOR THE ENGINEERING, DESIGN AND BID DOCUMENTS
FOR THE PROJECT KNOWN AS “LAKE ROAD RESURFACING PROJECT”,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City of Bay Village (BV) has agreed to complete the resurfacing of Lake Road (US Route 6), from the Lorain/Cuyahoga County Line to Longbeach Parkway, as a Local Public Agency (LPA) Project, with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT);

WHEREAS, the city will pay for all engineering, design, bid document and inspection costs related to this project;

WHEREAS, the construction costs for this project will be shared between ODOT and BV, at 85% and 15%, respectively;

WHEREAS, CT Consultants, Inc. provided a proposal to complete the engineering, design and bid documents required for this project at a total not-to-exceed fee of \$48,885.00;

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and she is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with CT Consultants, Inc., 8150 Sterling Court, Mentor, OH 44060, to proceed with engineering, design and bid documents relative to the Lake Road Resurfacing Project. Said work is said to be performed under contract at a cost not to exceed Forty Eight Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty Five Dollars (\$48,885.00). Payment shall be made from the Road Improvements – Street Maintenance and Repair Fund (270.310.55430).

SECTION 2. That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, property and safety, and for the further reason to provide services so that said resurfacing project may go forward expeditiously, wherefore this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
