AN ORDINANCE
**AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT TO OSBORN ENGINEERING FOR
PROFESSIONAL SERVICES RELATED TO THE HAIL DAMAGE CLAIM
FOR THE ROOFS ON CITY BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City of Bay Village filed an insurance claim regarding hail damages sustained to roofs on various city buildings and structures on May 9, 2010;

WHEREAS, the City of Bay Village was unable to reach an agreement with the insurance company on the extent of damages incurred from the hail storm;

WHEREAS, the City of Bay Village agreed to settle the claim through an appraisal process;

WHEREAS, the City decided it was in its best interest to hire an independent consultant to review the damage reports and provide input on the required repairs to the court agreed appraisers assigned to settle this claim;

SECTION 1 That the payment for professional services to Osborn Engineering, 1300 East 9th Street, Suite 1500, Cleveland, OH 44114 be authorized. Said professional services totaled Twenty Nine Thousand Six Hundred Forty-Nine and 94/100 Dollars (\$29,649.94). Payment shall be made from the Other Expenses – Roof Fund (496.790.54900).

SECTION 2. That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, property and safety, and for the further reason that said hail damage claims for city roofs can be settled, wherefore this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
