

ORDINANCE NO. 13-60

AN ORDINANCE
**AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH OSBORN
ENGINEERING FOR THE ENGINEERING, DESIGN AND BID DOCUMENTS FOR
THE PROJECT KNOWN AS “REBUILD OF THE SERVICE DEPARTMENT
TRANSFER STATION BUILDING,” AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the roof of the Service Department Transfer Station building collapsed on the existing building on May 29, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the city filed an insurance claim and said claim has been settled; and

WHEREAS, the city demolished the damaged building and wishes to rebuild a replacement structure; and

WHEREAS, the project requires the preparation of plans and specifications; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and she is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Osborn Engineering, 1300 East Ninth Street, Suite 1500, Cleveland, Ohio 44114, to proceed with engineering, design and bid documents relative to the Rebuild of the Service Department Transfer Station Building. Said work is said to be performed under contract at a cost not to exceed Twenty Four Thousand Dollars (\$24,000.00). Payment shall be made from the Public Improvements- Service Garage Buildings Fund (492-790-55323).

SECTION 2. That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, property and safety, and for the further reason to provide services so that said resurfacing project may go forward expeditiously, wherefore this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
