AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH SMITH-WHEELER, INC., (dba THE COURT SMITHS), FOR THE SPORTS SURFACING AT BRADLEY PARK TENNIS AND BASKETBALL COURTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Bay Village advertised for and received competitive bids on August 9, 2013 for the Sports Surfacing at Bradley Park Tennis & Basketball Courts; and

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and she is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Smith-Wheeler, Inc. (dba The Court Smiths), 4694 Bancroft St, Toledo, Ohio, 43615, for the Sports Surfacing at Bradley Park Tennis and Basketball Courts, in accordance with plans and specifications, it being hereby determined that the bid of said company is the lowest and best bid received after advertising according to law. Total bid price for said improvement is Thirty Two Thousand Five Hundred (\$32,500.00) and payment shall be made from the Land ImprovementFund/Bradley Park (490.790.55313).

SECTION 2. That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason to ensure that said surfacing project may go forward expeditiously, wherefore this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
