AN ORDINANCE

**AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH
CT CONSULTANTS, INC. FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES RELATIVE TO THE
ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE STORM SEWER AND PAVEMENT
INSTALLATION IN THE SUNSET AREA NEIGHBORHOOD, AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City initially engaged three engineering firms for proposals for the installation of new storm sewers and pavement, and

WHEREAS, two of the firms provided presentations to city officials and residents at a public meeting; and,

WHEREAS, CT Consultants, Inc. was selected as the firm to provide field surveying, project alternative analysis, meetings with residents, reparation of three alternative designs, and submission of an executive summary of the alternatives with cost estimates at the final deliverable;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and she is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with CT Consultants, Inc., Co., 8150 Sterling Court, Mentor, Ohio 44060 for the Sunset Area Storm Sewer and Pavement Replacement Project. Said work is said to be performed under contract at a cost not to exceed Thirty-four Thousand, Three Hundred and Twenty Dollars (\$34,320.00). Payment shall be made from the Sewer Architect and Engineering Fund (580.330.53220).

SECTION 2. That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, property and safety, and for the further reason to provide services so that said Sunset Area Sewer and Pavement Replacement project may go forward expeditiously, wherefore this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
