**AN ORDINANCE**

**AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE 13-83 REGARDING RATES OF COMPENSATION FOR THE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE GENERAL ADMINISTRATION DEPARTMENT AND THOSE EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY NOT COVERED BY SEPARATE LABOR CONTRACT FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2013 AND THEREAFTER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That November 18, 2013 the compensation to be paid to the officers and employees of the GENERAL ADMINISTRATION DEPARTMENT and those employees not covered by separate labor contract shall be:

In addition thereto, said Director of Law or his law firm, Seeley, Savidge, Ebert, and Gourash Co., LPA shall receive such additional compensation at an hourly rate as shall be approved by the Mayor upon statements duly rendered for services furnished in connection with any and all proceedings in Court as shall be approved by the Mayor, either Civil or Criminal, or before any Commission or Board (but) excepting appearances before any Bay Village Commission or Board, collection of R.I.T.A. claims or violations of Building Code or in connection with the settlement of any and all claims for or against the City.

The individual who may serve pro-tem as Secretary to Council or as Secretary to Planning Commission, Board of Zoning Appeals, Recreation Commission, Civil Service Commission, Architectural Board of Review, Tree Commission or Charter Review Committee shall be paid fifty dollars (\$50.00) for the first two hours of attendance and his or her hourly rate thereafter per regular or special meeting attended in lieu of wages.”

and present Section 1 of Ordinance 13-83 is hereby repealed.

**SECTION 2.** That it is found and determined that all formal actions concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 3.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is necessary to provide for compensation in conformance with agreements reached during labor negotiations and to secure adequate personnel for the City’s needs, wherefore this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
