

ORDINANCE NO. 13-130

**AN ORDINANCE**  
**AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH  
CT CONSULTANTS, INC. TO PROCEED WITH DESIGN SERVICES FOR THE  
REPLACEMENT OF THE WALKER-NANTUCKET PUMPING STATION,  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, CT Consultants, Inc. is under contract to the City of Bay Village to provide engineering services;

**WHEREAS**, the need to reconstruct the Walker-Nantucket Pump Station has been determined as part of the City's capital services plan;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That the Mayor be and she is hereby authorized to instruct CT Consultants, Inc., 8150 Sterling Court, Mentor, OH 44060, to proceed with the Investigation, Planning, Survey Phase, and Design Phase Services relative to the replacement of the existing Walker-Nantucket Pump Station. Said work is said to be performed under contract at a cost not to exceed Thirty Four Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$34,700.00). Payment shall be made from the Sewer Fund/Architectural and Engineering Fund (580.330.53220).

**SECTION 2.** That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.

**SECTION 3.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, property and safety, and for the further reason to provide services so that said pump station replacement project may go forward expeditiously, wherefore this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
