AN ORDINANCE
**AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE CHANGE ORDER #1 FOR
CHAGRIN VALLEY PAVING, INC., FOR THE 2012 PAVEMENT MAINTENANCE
AND RESURFACING PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City has an agreement with Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc. for the 2012 Pavement Maintenance and Resurfacing Program as authorized by Ordinance No. 12-47 passed June 4, 2012; and

WHEREAS, Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc. has submitted Change Order No. 1 for approval by the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio:


SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and she is hereby authorized to execute Change Order No. 1 for Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc., 17920 Munn Road, Chagrin Falls, Ohio, 44023, for the 2012 Pavement Maintenance and Resurfacing Program, adding the amount of \$17,053.04 to the cost of said project and bringing the total contract price to \$534,574.04. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to pay said additional sum of \$17,053.04 from the appropriation in the Street Maintenance and Repair Fund/Capital Improvements (270.310.55430).

SECTION 2. That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.


