AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING CODIFIED ORDINANCE SECTION 115.08 REGARDING
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Codified Ordinance Section 115.08 which presently reads as follows:

“115.08 NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING.

Notice of the public hearing shall be given by one publication in a newspaper of general circulation within the City, which newspaper need not meet the requirements of Ohio Revised Code 7.12 and which newspaper may be distributed by its publisher free of charge. In addition to the newspaper publication, notice of the hearing shall be posted at the ~~five~~ places designated in C.O. 113.01. The notice shall be published and posted at least on the fifth day preceding the day of public hearing. (Ord. 58-131. Passed 12-1-58.)”

be and the same is amended to read:

“115.08 NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING.

Notice of the public hearing shall be given by one publication in a newspaper of general circulation within the City, which newspaper need not meet the requirements of Ohio Revised Code 7.12 and which newspaper may be distributed by its publisher free of charge. In addition to the newspaper publication, notice of the hearing shall be posted at the ~~three~~ places designated in C.O. 113.01. The notice shall be published and posted at least on the fifth day preceding the day of public hearing.

and present section 115.08 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
