AN ORDINANCE  
AMENDING CODIFIED ORDINANCE SECTION 1310.05 REGARDING BOND

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That Codified Ordinance Section 1310.05 which presently reads as follows:

“1310.05 BOND.

When evidence discloses that the registrant has refused, failed or neglected to correct or abate violations of any applicable *code* or ordinance in performance of work done pursuant to a Certificate of Registration within a reasonable time after having been notified by the Building Director, the Building Director may require the registrant to furnish a performance bond in the amount of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) guaranteeing full and faithful compliance by the applicant with all provisions of any applicable *code* or ordinance of the City whenever the applicant for registration named as the principal on such bond refuses, neglects or fails to correct or abate such violation within a reasonable time set by the Building Director.”

be and the same is hereby amended to read:

1310.05 BOND.


When evidence discloses that the registrant has refused, failed or neglected to correct or abate violations of any applicable **standards** or ordinance in performance of work done pursuant to a Certificate of Registration within a reasonable time after having been notified by the Building Director, the Building Director may require the registrant to furnish a performance bond in the amount of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) guaranteeing full and faithful compliance by the applicant with all provisions of any applicable **standards** or ordinance of the City whenever the applicant for registration named as the principal on such bond refuses, neglects or fails to correct or abate such violation within a reasonable time set by the Building Director.

and present C. O. Section 1310.05 is hereby repealed.

**SECTION 2.** That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.

**SECTION 3.** That this ordinance will be in full force and take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
