To: Our Peddlers and Solicitors:

The City of Bay Village enacted legislation in 2013 which allows residents to restrict peddlers and solicitors from visiting their residences (Codified Ordinance 721.06 and 721.08)

In accordance with the ordinance, every peddler and solicitor must carry with them a copy of their permit and the current "Do Not Knock Registry". Peddlers and solicitors must not contact residents that are listed on the "Do Not Knock Registry" or who present a sticker on their home indicating "No Peddlers, Solicitors or Canvassers Allowed".

It is the responsibility of each peddler and solicitor to possess a current copy of the "Do Not Knock Registry" while working. A current version can be accessed by visiting the City of Bay Village website and clicking on the *Solicitor* tab on the top right of the page.

It is also the responsibility of each individual Peddler or Solicitor to be familiar with *Chapter 721- Peddlers and Solicitors*, of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bay Village. The ordinance specifies rules for the application and issuance of licenses, and restrictions on hours and conduct.
