On 05/03/2015, at 2032 hrs, a resident in the 23000 block of Lake Rd. called to report a suspicious vehicle parked in the driveway on a vacant house. As the caller was on the phone, the vehicle exited the driveway and drove north on Clague from Lake. Officers located the vehicle parked in the field north of Clague. After speaking with the 23 yoa male driver, officer's suspected the driver had been drinking. Field sobriety tests were administered, and as a result, the driver was arrested for OVI. The Rocky River resident will face charges at RRMC. Police are still investigating what he was doing at the vacant house, or if he caused any damage to the property.

On 05/02/2015, at 2000 hrs, a patron at Bay Village Presbyterian Church called BVPD to report her vehicle had been broken into. As officers were taking the report, they discovered that it appeared as though someone had also attempted to steal the vehicle. Police are investigating.
