On 07/13/2015, at 0239 hrs, a BVPD officer stopped a vehicle on Lake Rd. near Cahoon for a traffic violation. After speaking with the 19 yoa male driver, the officer suspected the driver had been using drugs. Field sobriety tests were administered, and as a result, the driver was arrested for OVI. The Amherst resident will face charges at RRMC.
