

RESOLUTION NO. 15-57

A RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A SAFETY INTERVENTION GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$40,000 FROM THE OHIO BUREAU OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION, DIVISION OF SAFETY AND HYGIENE, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING AND INSTALLING TWO (2) POWER LOAD SYSTEMS IN MEDIC UNITS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Bay Village, Division of Fire, has been informed by the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation, Division of Safety and Hygiene, that their grant application for the Safety Intervention Grant Program has been successful;

WHEREAS, the funds from his grant will be used to purchase and install two Power LOAD Systems in two Medic units, eliminating a significantly dangerous portion of the lifting of cots and patients into the back of the ambulance, thereby reducing the potential for on-the-job injury;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to accept the Safety Intervention Grant in the amount of \$40,000 from the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation, Division of Safety and Hygiene, for the purpose of purchasing and installing two (2) Power LOAD Systems in Medic Units.

SECTION 2. That Council agrees to approve and appropriate the amount of \$13,700.20 as their portion of the funding for this project made possible by the grant from the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.11 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reasons stated in the preamble hereof, wherefore this resolution shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.


