AN ORDINANCE
**AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE CHANGE ORDER #1F FOR
TRAX CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR THE WALMAR ROAD-CONCRETE
REPAIR CONTRACT OF THE 2015 PAVEMENT MAINTENANCE AND
RESURFACING PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City has an original agreement with TRAX Construction Company, 30701 Euclid Avenue, Wickliffe, Ohio 44092 in the amount of One Hundred Seventeen Thousand, Four Hundred Twenty-Five 00/100 dollars (\$117,425.00) as authorized by Ordinance No. 15-25 passed on March 30, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the final quantities for the project have been determined; and

WHEREAS, TRAX Construction Company has submitted Change Order #1F for approval by the City;


BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and she is hereby authorized to execute Change Order #1F for TRAX Construction Company, 30701 Euclid Avenue, Wickliffe, Ohio 44092, for the Walmar Road Concrete Repair Contract of the 2015 Pavement Maintenance and Resurfacing Program, adding the amount of Fifty-Six Thousand, Nine Hundred Seventy-Six Dollars and Sixty-nine Cents (\$56,976.69) to the total of said contract and bringing the final contract price to One Hundred Seventy-Four Thousand, Four Hundred One Dollars and Sixty-nine cents (\$174,401.69) and payments shall be made from the Street Maintenance and Repair Fund/Capital Roads Improvements (270.310.55430).

SECTION 2. That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to execute said Change Order, wherefore this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
