**AN ORDINANCE**  
**AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE CHANGE ORDER #1F FOR  
CHAGRIN VALLEY PAVING, INC. FOR THE ASPHALT RESURFACING  
CONTRACT OF THE 2015 PAVEMENT MAINTENANCE AND RESURFACING  
PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the City has an original agreement with Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc., 17290 Munn Road, Chagrin Falls, Ohio 44023 in the amount of Five Hundred Seventeen Thousand, Three Hundred Twenty Dollars and Thirty Seven Cents (\$517,320.37) as authorized by Ordinance No. 15-24 passed on March 30, 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, the final quantities for the project have been determined; and

**WHEREAS**, Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc. has submitted Change Order #1F for approval by the City;

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That the Mayor be and she is hereby authorized to execute Change Order #1F for Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc., 17290 Munn Road, Chagrin Falls, Ohio 44023, for the Asphalt Resurfacing Contract of the 2015 Pavement Maintenance and Resurfacing Program, adding the amount of Twenty Six Thousand, Six Hundred Thirty Five Dollars and Forty Eight Cents (\$26,635.48) to the total of said contract and bringing the final contract price to Five Hundred Forty Three Thousand, Nine Hundred Fifty Five Dollars and Eighty Five Cents (\$543,955.85) and payments shall be made from the Street Maintenance and Repair Fund/Capital Roads Improvements (270.310.55430).

**SECTION 2.** That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.

**SECTION 3.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to execute said Change Order, wherefore this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
