On 08/18/2015, at 5:59 am, a homeowner reported a suspicious occupied vehicle in the 26000 block of Henry Road. BVPD officers found the vehicle and spoke with the young couple inside. Officers learned that they were soon parting ways in their relationship. The female occupant refused any assistance from police and stated she would be dropped off at her home by the male operator. The couple was advised of the complaint and they refused further police assistance
