On 09/20/2015, at 0014 hrs, a BVPD officer stopped a vehicle on Columbia Rd. at Eaton Way for a traffic violation. After speaking to the 34 yoa male driver the officer suspected the driver had been drinking. Field sobriety tests were administered, and as a result the driver was arrested for OVI. The Westlake resident will face charges at RRMC.

AT&T was contacted by BVPD, and they stated they do not do business this way, and that the call was a scam. The caller was advised.
