On 09/25/15, at 3:14am, A Bay Village Officer was on patrol in the area of Lake Road at Cahoon Road when he noticed a vehicle commit a traffic infraction. The officer stopped the vehicle and spoke with the operator, a female, 44 year old, Avon Lake resident, who appeared to be under the influence of alcohol. The operator failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the operator blew over the legal limit. She is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.

On 09/27/15 at 1:39am, a female caller from the Knickerbocker Apartments (27100 Knickerbocker Road) called BVPD to report she heard a series of loud bangs coming from across the street from her. She could see a small slender white male kicking in the door to one of the businesses on Knickerbocker before he left the area walking eastbound. Officers arrived and found a door had been kicked in but no entry was made to the building. The area was checked but the male could not be found. The owner of the business arrived on scene and was able to secure the building. BVPD is investigating.

On 09/27/15 at 3:47am, a Bay Village Police Officer stopped a vehicle on Lake Road, near Breezewood Road for a traffic violation. The officer spoke with the male operator, a 24 year old Warrensville Heights resident. The officer suspected the male was under the influence of alcohol. The operator failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the operator provided a breath sample which showed a .122% BAC. He is currently facing charges in RRMC.
