AN ORDINANCE
**AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN EXTENSION TO
THE LABOR AGREEMENT WITH OHIO PATROLMEN'S BENEVOLENT
ASSOCIATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, a Labor Agreement was entered into between the City of Bay Village and Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association, as authorized by Ordinance No. 13-81 passed September 16, 2013; and

WHEREAS, said existing Labor Agreement remains in effect until a new Agreement is reached; and

WHEREAS, an extension has been agreed to extending the current contract until January 31, 2016;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio:


SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and she is hereby authorized to enter into an extension to the Labor Agreement through January 31, 2016 with the Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association.

SECTION 2. That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide for compensation and employment provisions agreed upon in labor negotiations, wherefore this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
