On 12/27/2015, at 2357 hrs, a resident in the 300 block of Plymouth called BVPD to report the lights were on in a neighbor's house and the neighbor was out of town. Responding officers checked the house and located the owner inside. They had returned home early from vacation. BVPD reminds resident's to please call immediately if you observe anything suspicious.
