On 01/24/2016, at 0322 hrs, a taxi driver called BVPD to report he was having a problem with several fares who was refusing to pay, and who were also harassing him. There were two adult males and females involved, and the intoxicated males had already exited the cab and ran into a house in the 23000 block of Wolf Rd. The homeowner of the house the males ran into eventually came out and paid the driver to resolve the situation. The driver desired no further police involvement.
