



## **Bay Village Press Release**

**03/14/2016**

On March 9, at 2:59am, a worker at the Bradley Bay Health Center called Bay Village Police to report that a highly intoxicated male just entered their facility looking for directions. The male then walked away from the building. Officers responded and found the male, a 53 year old, Bay Village resident, laying passed out under a tree nearby. Officer placed the male under arrest for disorderly conduct – intoxication and transported him back to the BVPD police station. He is facing charges at Rocky River Municipal Court.

On March 12, at 11:17pm, Bay Village Police received a call from Avon Police reporting a possible intoxicated driver heading to his home in Bay Village. Officers responded and found the suspect, entering the city and committing numerous traffic violations. Officers stopped the vehicle and spoke with the 63 year old male operator, who appeared to be under the influence of alcohol. The male failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. He is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.

On March 13, at 6:35am, Bay Village Police received a call from a Lincoln Road resident who stated that two males were just walking down the street throwing people's newspapers into the air. Cars were dispatched and found the two males in the area. The males, both Bay Village residents ages 19 and 20, were under the influence of alcohol. They were both arrested and will face charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.
