On 05/18/2016, at 0027 hrs, a BVPD officer located a car parked in Cahoon Park near the Boat Club after hours. The two adult occupants were just talking. They were advised and sent on their way.

On 05/18/2016, at 1210 hrs, a Breezewood resident reported that her personal information was used by someone to open several credit card accounts. Police are investigating.

On 05/19/2016, at 1354 hrs, BVPD officers were dispatched to City Hall for an irate citizen who was complaining about some of his back taxes from 2009. He had calmed down and left the building by the time officers arrived, and police involvement was no longer required.

On 05/19/2016, at 1641 hrs, a Rye Gate resident called to report she had received two automated voicemails demanding that she call them back to discuss criminal charges against her. If she did not call the number back within 24 hrs, "local cops" would come arrest her. She realized the calls were scams and did not call them back. BVPD reminds residents to be very cautious of unsolicited phone calls.
