On 07/12/2016, at 0204 hrs, a BVPD officer stopped a vehicle on Lake Rd. at Sandalwood for a traffic violation. As a result of the traffic stop, a 22 yoa male Bay Village resident was charged with Contributing to the Delinquency of a Minor. An 18 yoa male Bay Village resident was charged with Underage Consumption and Contributing to the Delinquency of a Minor. A 19 yoa male Bay Village resident was charged with Underage Consumption and Contributing to the Delinquency of a Minor. A 19 yoa male Westlake resident was charged with Contributing to the Delinquency of a Minor, Underage Consumption, and Possession of Marijuana. They will all face charges at RRMC. A 15 yoa male Bay Village resident was charged with a Curfew violation. He will face charges a CCJC.

On the overnight hours of 07/13/2016, numerous unlocked vehicles were entered in the area of Carlton, Appleblossom, and Winsor. Police are investigating. BVPD reminds residents to please remove valuable from your vehicles and lock the doors.

On 07/13/2016, at 0213 hrs, a resident in the 30000 block of Winsor reported that a vehicle had been stolen out of her garage. The vehicle was equipped with OnStar and the owner was able to ping the vehicle on Pear Avenue in Cleveland. CPD responded to the scene and located the unoccupied vehicle. The vehicle was processed and returned to the owner. Police are investigating.

On 02/16/2016, at 0224 hrs, a BVPD officer attempted to stop a vehicle on Dover Center near Lake Rd. for a traffic violation. The vehicle did not stop and a pursuit was initiated. The operator of the vehicle pulled away from the pursuing officer, and proceeded to wreck the car at Park Drive and Lake Rd. The driver of the vehicle fled the scene on foot. Officers searched the area but were unable to locate the driver. While investigating, officers learned that the vehicle had just been stolen from a resident in the 27000 block of Knickerbocker. Police were able to identify the driver after speaking to the owner. Westlake PD located the driver later that day walking around the area of Columbia Rd. and Detroit Rd. He was taken into custody without incident. The 19 yoa Cleveland resident will face multiple charges at Cuyahoga County Court of Common Pleas.
