Numerous Bay Village residents reported receiving scam phone calls from someone claiming to be a representative of the IRS. BVPD reminds residents not to give out any of their personal information over the phone.

On 07/21/2016, at 0919 hrs, BVPD recovered two vehicles that had previously been reported stolen. They were located in Cleveland. Both of the vehicles were towed back to BVPD for processing. Police are still investigating.

On 07/22/2016, at 1802 hrs, a caller reported there was a group of juveniles at Columbia Rd. Beach that appeared as though they were getting ready fight. Responding officers located the group that was involved. Four juvenile males got into an argument with an adult beach goer about the juveniles throwing their empty beer cans around. After speaking with the four juveniles, officers suspected they had all been drinking. Field sobriety tests were administered, and as a result all four of the juveniles were arrested for Underage Consumption of Alcohol. The juvenile instigator of the argument was also charged with Menacing. The four Parma residents will face charges at CCJC.

On 07/23/2016, at 1249 hrs, a Saddler Rd. resident reported that she had been scammed out of \$3,500 by a person in Virginia on a dating website. Police are investigating.

On 07/21/2016, at 0151 hrs, a BVPD officer stopped a vehicle on Columbia Rd. near Wolf Rd. for a traffic violation. After speaking with the 49 yoa female driver, the officer suspected the driver had been drinking. Field sobriety tests were administered, and as a result, she was arrested for OVI. She was additionally charged with Child Endangerment because she had four juvenile passengers in the vehicle with her. The Rocky River resident will face charges at RRMC.
