On 08/16/2016, at 2029 hrs, a Bay Village Service Department employee called BVPD to report a group of juveniles were trespassing at the service garage and climbing on some of the trucks parked in the fenced in parking area. Police responded but the juveniles were gone. No damage was located.

On 08/18/2016, at 0325 hrs, a resident in the 300 block of Bassett called BVPD to report she could see a person with a flashlight going through the cars in her driveway. The caller last saw the person walking west through the backyards. BVPD responded to the area but were unable to locate the person. Nothing was taken from the vehicles. BVPD reminds resident to please lock your vehicles and not to leave valuables in them.

suspected the driver had been drinking. Field sobriety tests were administered, and as a result 58 yoa driver was arrested for OVI. The Avon Lake resident will face charges at RRMC.
