On 09/04/2016, at 0739 hours, a resident on Canterbury Rd called on 911 to say her live-in boyfriend kicked in a door when she locked him outside. Officers arrested the 52 year old male for disorderly conduct/intoxication. After 6 hours of sleeping it off in the Bay Village Police jail he was released with a minor misdemeanor citation in hand.

On 09/04/2016, at 0030 hrs, a Bay Village officer made a routine traffic stop on Lake Rd, near Porter Creek Dr. After the officer noted a heavy odor of burnt marijuana coming from the vehicle he conducted a PC (probable cause) search of the vehicle's interior and occupants. Two juveniles were taken into custody and turned over to relatives. The adult operator received a traffic citation. A small amount of marijuana was confiscated.

On 08/29/2016, at 1949 hrs, a 911 caller on Midland Rd reports a male laying in her driveway unconscious. Officers arrived and found him lying underneath the homeowner's car. Narcan was administered. The male was transported to St. John Medical Center.

On 08/29/2016, at 1235 hrs, the station received a report of an injured red tail hawk on Sandalwood Dr. There were no obvious signs of injury to the raptor. It was placed in a box and transported to the Lake Erie Nature and Science Center. Staff members said it appeared to have the West Nile virus. They will treat accordingly.
