On Sept. 15, 2016 around 4pm, BVPD received a call from Normandy Elementary School reporting a 5 year old student was not picked up from school. Additionally, when the school staff made contact with the student's mother, the mother "sounded impaired". Officers were dispatched to the home, 400 block of Columbia, and found the mother hiding in the basement with her 3 year old child. The mother was subsequently arrested due to having outstanding warrants with Bay Village PD, Westlake PD and Cuyahoga County Sheriff's Office. The 22 year old mother is also facing Child Endangering charges at RRMCC.

On Sept. 16, 2016, a resident in the 30000 block of Winsor reports their snow blower was stolen from an unlocked shed sometime between August 21 and now. Bay Village Police remind all residents to make sure their cars, sheds and homes are always secured.

On Sept. 17, 2016, Lake Road was closed between Bradley and the County Line for nearly 9 ½ hours after a large tree fell, taking power lines down with it.

On Sept. 18, 2016, A BVPD officer stopped a vehicle on Lake Rd. near Long Beach for a traffic violation. After speaking to the female driver, the officer suspected the driver had been drinking. Field sobriety tests were administered. As a result of the tests, the driver was arrested for OVI. The 27 year old Avon Lake resident will face charges at RRMCC.
