On 02/22/2018, at 0744 hrs, BVPD responded to a head on crash on Wolf Rd. near Forestview. Upon investigating the crash and speaking to the involved drivers, officers believed the driver of the at fault vehicle was under the influence of drugs. The 45-year old female was transported to the hospital for injuries she sustained as a result of the crash. The Bay Village resident was later processed and released from BVPD. She will face charges for OVI at RRMC.

On 02/24/2018, at 0227 hrs, a BVPD officer stopped a vehicle on Wolf Rd. at Upland for a traffic violation. After speaking with the female driver, officers suspected the driver had been drinking. Field sobriety tests were administered, and as a result, the driver was arrested for OVI. The 47-year old Bay Village resident will face charges at RRMC.

On 02/25/2018, at 0106 hrs, a BVPD officer stopped a vehicle on Dover Center near Normandy for speeding. After speaking with the driver, the officer suspected the driver had been drinking. Field sobriety tests were administered, and as a result, the 33-year old female was arrested for OVI. The Illinois resident will face charges at RRMC.

On 02/25/2018, at 0909 hrs, BVPD was dispatched to a house on Northfield on the report of a male prying open the back door with a crowbar. Officers located the male and determined he was part of a construction crew prepping the house for demolition. BVPD reminds residents to please report suspicious activity immediately.

On 02/25/2018, at 1429 hrs, a Manhasset resident reported he had fallen victim to a scam. He received a call from someone claiming to be his grandson. The male stated he had been arrested, and needed \$2,000 to be wired to him via Western Union. The male complied, and wired \$500. He later realized he had been scammed. Police are investigating.
