### **03/19/2018**

On 03/12/2018, at 0056 hrs, a BVPD officer stopped a vehicle on Bradley near Wolf for a traffic violation. After speaking with the 24-year old male driver, the officer suspected that he had been drinking. Field sobriety tests were administered, and as a result, the driver was arrested for OVI. A search of the vehicle incident to arrest revealed suspected illegal designer drugs. The Avon Lake resident will face charges for OVI and Drug Possession at RRMC.

On 03/12/2018, at 0857 hrs, a business owner in the 27000 block of East Oviatt called BVPD to report one of his work trucks had been broken into over the weekend. Numerous tools were stolen. The incident was caught on video and police are investigating.

On 03/13/2018, at 0716 hrs, a resident in the 500 block of Upland reported that his red Honda Civic had been stolen overnight. Police are investigating.

On 03/14/2018, at 1645 hrs, a Heinen's employee called BVPD to report the theft of six bottles of champagne that had occurred earlier. The incident was captured on video. Police are investigating.

On 03/16/2018, at 1636 hrs, BVPD officers were dispatched to the area of Clague on a mutual aid request from WPD. There had been a crash on the I-90 overpass and a passenger from one of the vehicles walked away from the scene. Officers located the male sitting in Reese Park. The male had an active warrant with Lorain PD, and according to witnesses, left the scene carrying a black bag, which he no longer had with him. Officers located the black bag in a nearby dumpster, and the male claimed ownership. The bag contained suspected drugs. The 26-year old male was taken into custody for Obstructing Official Business. Further charges are pending lab tests on the suspected drugs. The Lorain resident will face charges at RRMC.
