07/30/2018

On 07/27/2018, at 0326 hours, an officer on routine patrol stopped a GMC Terrain on Lake Road, near Cahoon road, after observing traffic violations indicating possible driver impairment. The 31-year old Bay Village resident failed field sobriety tests and was arrested for OVI. During the pre-tow inventory of his vehicle an electronic vaporizer device, containing a brown liquid, was found and impounded. At the station, the brown liquid tested positive for marijuana/THC. After processing, the male was released to a sober party on personal bond. He will face multiple charges at Rocky River Municipal Court.

On 07/27/2017, at 1327 hours, an officer was dispatched to Martin's Deli in reference to a theft complaint. The officer spoke to an employee who reported the previous evening, a juvenile had stolen four cans of "tall boy" 24 oz. Twisted Tea alcoholic beverages. The establishment had recorded video surveillance of the incident. The officer saw the recording, which clearly showed the male place the items in his backpack. Information was taken for the report and the officer was going to begin the process of identifying the suspect. On 07/29/2018, at 2200 hours, a Bay Village resident arrived in the police lobby, accompanied by his 15-year old son. The boy's mother had seen a Facebook posting seeking the identity of the thief and recognized her son.

On 07/28/2018, at 1053 hours, a resident called to report on Lake Road, near Dover Center Road, she had pulled into the driveway of a friend's house when another vehicle pulled in behind her. The female driver appears to be highly intoxicated. Officers found a 54-year old Westlake resident who was indeed, deep in her cups. She thought she was in Westlake and asked the officers to take her home. Due to her level of intoxication, she had to be helped out of her car so an attempt could be made to have her perform field sobriety tests. She failed and was arrested for OVI. When initially placed into the back seat of the patrol car she began kicking the door and slamming her forehead in the passenger's side door cage. She fell asleep while en route to the station. At the station, she refused to take any tests and was eventually released to her sister on personal bond.
