## What is ReadyNotify?

ReadyNotify is a mass notification system used by Bay Village and other municipalities in Cuyahoga County. Its primary use is for emergency notifications, when rapid and accurate information is essential for your immediate safety.

## What type of notifications will I receive?

You can expect to receive notifications about:

- Emergency Events
- Water Boil Alerts
- Safety Messages

## What type of information is required to register?

Participation in ReadyNotify is voluntary though strongly suggested. The ReadyNotify system represents a valuable communication tool for both our city and its residents during emergency situations. During the registration process you will be asked to provide information about yourself such as your name, address, phone number, and if you require any special assistance during an emergency event. To register please complete this form and return it to City Hall or Dwyer Senior Center. This form can also be put in the sewer box after hours. We will get you registered.
