The Bay Village Police Department would like to extend sincere thanks to the Bay Village Auxiliary who were of tremendous help during the widespread damage that occurred during the wind storm on February 24.

On February 26, 2019 at 1:16am, Bay Village Police stopped a vehicle for a moving traffic violation on Lake Road at Eagle Cliff Drive. The registered owner, a 61 year old Avon resident, appeared to be under the influence and failed field sobriety tests. The male was also in possession of marijuana during the traffic stop. On station, the male provided a breath sample which showed a .108% blood alcohol content. He is facing numerous charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.

On February 26, 2019 at 5:41pm, Bay Village Police received a call about a fraud. The Kenilworth Road resident stated they had sent \$500 for a puppy via a website. The breeder however, has not responded to further communications. The Bay Village Detective Bureau is investigating.

On March 1, 2109 at 11:07pm, Bay Village Police were contacted by the Bay Village Food Mart, reporting someone was in the store trying to purchase alcohol with fake identification. Two juvenile females were in the store attempting to purchase beer. The two girls (ages 15 and 16) were charged with alcohol violations and possession of a fake identification. Two other juveniles, waiting for their friends in their vehicle outside, were also charged.

On March 3, 2019 at 1:13am, Bay Village Police stopped a vehicle on Lake Road at Lake Forest Drive. The female operator, a 46 year old Bay Village resident, appeared to be under the influence. The operator failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the female provided a breath sample which showed a .156 blood alcohol content. She is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.
