On 03/06/2019, at 14:18 hours, officers was dispatched to O'Neill Healthcare on Bradley Road on the report of one employee attempting to assault another. Investigation found that there has been ongoing tension between the two, which culminated in a dispute in the break room. While one employee was washing dishes in the sink, the other employee, from a distance of four feet placed a 6" long serrated knife into the same sink. The victim stated the knife was thrown forcefully, narrowly missing her hands. The alleged assailant said she simply "tossed" the knife into the sink. The information has been presented to the prosecutor for a ruling.

On 03/09/2019, at 23:24 hours, an officer stopped a vehicle on Bradley Road for speeding, and other traffic violations, on Lake Road. The officer surmised the operator might be under the influence of alcohol and had him perform roadside sobriety tests. After failing, the 49-year old male from Altoona, Pennsylvania was arrested for DUI. He was processed back at the station and later released on bond to a sober adult.

On 03/10/2019, at 10:55 hours, a resident who lives on Revere Drive came to the station to report that in December of 2018 she hired a person to do electrical work at her home and gave him a personal check for \$300.00. The check was cashed, but the 26-year old male from Elyria has not returned to do the contracted work and will not return the victim's calls. The Detective Bureau is following up.
