



## **Bay Village Press Release**

On Wednesday, April 24 at 2:36 am, Bay Village Police stopped a vehicle in the area of Lake Road and Columbia Road for a moving traffic infraction. Officers spoke to the male operator, a 19 year-old Bay Village resident and the female passenger, a 19 year-old Rocky River resident. The pair both appeared to be under the influence of alcohol. The operator failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest for OVI. The female was placed under arrest for Underage Consumption and both were transported to the Bay Village Police Department. On station, the male refused to provide a breath sample. Officers also found a fake I.D. in his possession. Both are facing numerous charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.

On Friday, April 26, 2019 at 2:38 am, Bay Village Police stopped a vehicle in the area of Cahoon Road and Osborn Road for a traffic infraction. Officers spoke to the male operator, a 49-year-old Bay Village resident. The operator appeared to be under the influence of alcohol. The operator failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the male provided a breath sample which showed a .202 blood alcohol content. He is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.

On Sunday, April 28 at 12:48am, Bay Village Police were dispatched to the area of Lake Road and Columbia Road for a possible intoxicated driver. Once in the area, police found that the suspect vehicle had struck, and was stuck on, a fire hydrant. The male operator, a 38 year-old Cuyahoga Falls resident, was at the scene and appeared to be under the influence. The male failed field sobriety tests and was taken into custody. The male and his vehicle were searched. Officers found various illegal drugs, a loaded handgun, and counterfeit U.S. currency. On station, the male refused to submit to a chemical test to check for drugs in his system. The male was bound over to Cuyahoga County Court of Common Pleas where he is facing numerous felony charges.
