On April 28, 2019 at 5:26pm, Bay Village Police received a call from the Bay Village Walgreens reporting that a Hispanic male had just stolen cell phones and left the area in a red Nissan. Bay Officers were dispatched and surrounding cities were notified for mutual aid. Bay Officers also thought to check the Bay Village CVS where they found the suspect male, a 39 year-old Cleveland resident. The male was taken into custody for the theft charge. It was later discovered that the male had an active warrant with a neighboring jurisdiction and was on parole. The male was charged with Theft and Possession of Criminal Tools and will be seen at Rocky River Municipal Court.

On May 4, 2019 at 2:56am, Bay Village Police stopped a vehicle on Cahoon Road by the railroad tracks for a traffic violation. The female operator, a 35 year-old Northfield resident appeared to be under the influence. The operator failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the operator refused to submit to a breath test. She is facing numerous charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.
