On June 20, 2019 at 1:32am, Bay Village Police were on patrol in the area of Knickerbocker Road and Clague Parkway. The officer noticed a male and a female out walking. Upon approach, the female appeared to be underage and out past curfew. The officer spoke with the pair and found that the 16 year old female was with a 20 year old male. After checking with the female's parents, it was found that she had lied to her parents about her location. The male was charged with Contributing to the Delinquency of a Minor, the female was charged with Minor's Curfew violation.

On June 21, 2019 at 5:33 pm, Bay Village Police were called to the Bay Village Food Mart upon report of a minor trying to purchase alcohol. The Food Mart clerk called police when a 21 year old female bought alcohol and was seen putting it in the vehicle of another person who appeared underage. Officers responded and found that the recipient was only 18 years old. Both are facing alcohol charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.

On June 22, 2019 at 12:40 am, Bay Village Police stopped a vehicle on Aberdeen Road at Cahoon Road for an equipment violation. Officers approached the vehicle and spoke with the male driver, a 38 year old Cleveland resident and the female passenger, a 36 year old Cleveland resident. Officers also noticed drug paraphernalia in plain sight inside the vehicle. A probable cause search of vehicle was conducted. Officers found drugs, additional paraphernalia and numerous suspected stolen gift cards in the vehicle. The Bay Village Detective Bureau is investigating and charges are pending.
