On July 9, 2019 at 6:15pm, Bay Village Police took report of a scam involving MLB All-Star Game tickets. A Bay resident arrived on station to report that he attempted to purchase tickets on Craigslist. The victim sent money to the seller through an online app but never received the tickets. Bay Village Detectives are investigating.

On July 11, 2019 at 11:27am, Bay Village Police stopped a vehicle on Bradley Road near Walker Road for a moving traffic infraction. The male operator, a 48 year old Avon Lake resident, appeared to be operating the vehicle while under the influence. The operator failed field sobriety tests, was placed under arrest for OVI, and was transported back to the police station. On station, the male submitted to a breath test which showed a .063 blood alcohol content. Upon a search, the suspect male was found with numerous prescription pills on his person, none of which were prescribed to him. The male agreed to submit to a urine test. The male is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court. Additional charges may be filed upon results of lab tests.

On July 12, 2019 at 1:47am Bay Village Police stopped a vehicle on Dover Center Road at Midland Road for a moving traffic infraction. The male operator, a 50 year old Sagamore Hills resident, appeared to be operating a vehicle while under the influence. The operator failed field sobriety tests, was placed under arrest, and was transported back to the police station. On station, the male refused to submit to a breath test to check his blood alcohol content. While searching the vehicle, a half-full pint glass filled with alcohol was found inside the vehicle. The male is facing numerous charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.

On July 13, 2019 at 9:47pm, Bay Village Police were dispatched to the area of 625 Dover Center Road (CVS Pharmacy) on report of a male and female in a dispute. Officers arrived and found the 33 year old male and the 41 year old female were both intoxicated and were feuding over an incident that happened at a bar earlier in the evening. The feuding couple were eventually both arrested for Disorderly Conduct – Intoxication. They are facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.
