

City of Bay Village Regulations

PARKING PROHIBITIONS: No person shall park a motor vehicle on any street for a period longer than 30 minutes between the hours of 2:30 A.M. and 5:00 A.M. Parking on the city streets is also prohibited for a period of time longer than six hours between the hours of 5:00 A.M. and 2:30 A.M. the following day.

BICYCLES: All bicycles must be licensed. The license may be obtained at the Police Station and the fee is \$1.00. Bicycle riding is prohibited on Dover Center Rd., Columbia Rd., and Clague Rd. Sidewalks must be used on these highly traveled roads.

JOGGING: Jogging is prohibited on Lake Rd., Walker Rd., Wolf Rd., Clague Rd., Columbia Rd., Dover Center Rd., Cahoon Rd., Bassett Rd., Bradley Rd., and Osborn Rd. west of Cahoon Rd. Jogging must be confined to the sidewalks on these streets.

SPRINKLING BAN: During the period from June 1 through September 15, and between the hours of 6:00 A.M. and 10 P.M. of each year, no person shall use any water from the public water system for the purpose of sprinkling, except that sprinkling will be permitted on even numbered days if the last digit of the house number is even, and on odd numbered days if the last digit of the house number is odd.

LAWN CUTTING: Power lawn mowers and other power equipment shall not be operated between the hours of 9:00 P.M. and 8:00 A.M.

SNOW SHOVELING: Sidewalks shall be kept clear of snow and ice to a width of 24 inches. Removal must take place within 24 hours after the abatement of the snowstorm.

PARK REGULATIONS: City parks are normally open between the hours of 5:00 A.M. and 11:00 P.M., unless otherwise posted. Alcohol is prohibited within any city park. Use of Cahoon Park is limited to city residents or their invited guests. Boating, bathing, games or sports shall not be permitted in Cahoon Park on Sundays.

ANIMAL REGULATIONS: Owners of dogs or cats shall at all times be in control of the animal. Allowing dogs or cats to enter upon private property is prohibited. No person shall keep or harbor any animal that barks, howls, or bites any person to the annoyance of the residents of the city.

CURFEW: Minor curfew is as follows: Up to and including age fifteen, 11:00 P.M. 5:00 A.M. the following morning. Age sixteen to and including age seventeen, 1:00 A.M. to 5:00 A.M. the same day.

RESIDENTIAL ALARMS: An alarm permit must be obtained from the Police Division for any audible or direct connect alarm within the city.

“KEG” LAW: No person being the owner or occupant of any premises within the city shall knowingly allow any person under the age of twenty-one years to remain on the premises while in possession of intoxicating liquor or beer or while consuming intoxicating liquor or beer.

OPERATION IDENTIFICATION: The Police Division has electric etchers available to residents free of charge to use for marking personal property.

VACATION WATCH: Notify the Police Division when leaving on vacation or any other extended absences from your home.

HOME SECURITY SURVEYS: The Police Division has officers available who will come to your home and offer suggestions on how to better protect your home.
