**APPROVAL OF MINUTES** – Mr. Polinski made a motion to approve the minutes from September as written, motion was seconded and approved by all present.

**OLD BUSINESS**

Mr. Sattler said he is going to walk the Red Oak Lane area, the south side, on Wednesday (tomorrow) afternoon around 3:00 p.m. – 3:15 p.m. to talk to residents in the area. If anyone would like to meet him there and walk the area where the proposed development would be, feel free to join him. He commented that the area did flood with the big rainstorm. Mrs. Jesionowski and Mr. Ludwig said they may go. Mr. Sattler said that at the last meeting they were waiting to hear from FEMA regarding the floodplain.

**ARBORIST REPORT**

**FALL TREE PLANTING** - Mr. Polinski reported that this will be a smaller fall planting this year. Planting requests from 2018 through September, 2020 will be planted and will bring the planting requests up to date. There will be additional replacements planted in the parks. The area by the new walking trail will need to be planted in the spring due to a settling issue with the asphalt.

**ARBOR DAY** – Mr. Sattler reported that he is working with the Sea Scouts. He has the Red Bud seedlings from the Sea Scouts and will pick up 2-inch Red Buds for their planting project. He will be going to the nursery and can pick up the Red Buds. He said that when the City is ready to plant them, just let him know and he will drop them off.

Mr. Polinski said the State dropped the Arbor Day Celebration requirement for Tree City U.S.A. this year because of Covid. He will let Mr. Sattler know when the planting can be done.

Ms. Jesionowski said she looked at the new City website. She wanted to know if there will be anything regarding Tree Commission.
