

ORDINANCE NO. 16-19

AN ORDINANCE
**ACCEPTING A BID AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER
INTO A CONTRACT WITH ECOVERSE INDUSTRIES, LTD FOR THE PURCHASE
OF A WINDROW TURNER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and she is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Ecoverse Industries, Ltd., 1265 Lear Industrial Parkway, Avon, Ohio 44011, for the purchasing of one (1) Backhaus A55 Model self-propelled straddle type windrow turner, less trade-in allowance by seller, for use at the City of Westlake Compost Facility. The prices are as follows:

EQUIPMENT: **One (1) Backhaus A55 Model self-propelled straddle type windrow turner less trade-in allowance of existing 1989 Scarab Model 18 windrow turner by seller (-\$15,000.00).**

PRICE: **Not to exceed \$356,650.00, of which fifty percent (50%) shall be paid by the City of Westlake and fifty percent (50%) shall be paid by the City of Bay Village.**

The bid of said Company is hereby determined to be the lowest and best bid received by the City of Westlake after advertising according to law. The agreement shall be in a form approved by the Director of Law, and the Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to pay said contract price from funds appropriated for the purpose.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance be and she is hereby authorized and directed to issue warrants of the City of Bay Village for said equipment to the supplier listed in Section 1 above in an amount not to exceed the sum One Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand Three Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars and Zero Cents (\$178,325.00).

SECTION 3. That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary to continue the efficiency of the Westlake-Bay Village Compost Facility, wherefore this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
