**A RESOLUTION**  
**AMENDING RESOLUTION 17-8 AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF TWO LAW ENFORCEMENT VEHICLES UNDER COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM WITH THE STATE OF OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City of Bay Village has entered into a cooperative purchasing program with the State of Ohio to participate in State contracts which the Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing, has entered into for the purchase of supplies, services, equipment and certain material pursuant to ORC §125.04; and

WHEREAS, the cooperative purchasing programs, after public bidding, will determine the vendor that is the best vendor(s) for the vehicles listed below in Section 1. **However, the City of Bay Village can purchase those supplies, services and equipment from another party upon equivalent terms, conditions and specifications but at a lower price than it can through Cooperative Purchasing Program with the State of Ohio; and**

WHEREAS, the City of Bay Village Police Department is in need of the vehicles listed below meeting these specifications;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by Council of the City of Bay Village, Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That the Chief of the Division of Police is hereby authorized and directed to submit purchase order(s) for the purchase of two (2) police vehicles outfitted with graphics, lighting and security under the cooperative purchasing program of the State of Ohio. **However, the City of Bay Village can purchase those supplies, services and equipment from another party upon equivalent terms, conditions and specifications but at a lower price than it can through Cooperative Purchasing Program with the State of Ohio.** Total contract price not to exceed \$62,000.00, including delivery; shall be paid from the Equipment Replacement Fund / Police (240.111.55220).

**SECTION 2.** That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with law.


**SECTION 3.** That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessarily for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to submit said purchase order to meet the cut-off date for ordering law enforcement vehicles, wherefore this resolution shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
