On 01/20/2020, at 0119 hrs, BVPD received a call from a city plow driver reporting there was an occupied car parked on Bruce near Park, and the vehicle was refusing to move for him. BVPD responded and the vehicle was occupied by an 18-yoa male. Officers suspected there were drugs in the car and conducted a probable cause search of the vehicle. Officers located marijuana, prescription drugs, and alcohol inside the vehicle. The Lakewood resident was arrested and later released after posting bond. He will face charges at RRMC.
