



Bay Village Press Release

On January 20, at 1:19am, Bay Village Police received a call from a Bay Village Service Department employee who was out plowing roads. The plow driver reported that there was a suspicious vehicle parked on Bruce Road. The vehicle was occupied, and when approached to move his vehicle so the street could be plowed, refused to do so. Police arrived and spoke with the male operator, an 18 year-old Bay Village resident, who appeared to be under the influence. Officers found that the male was in possession of alcohol, marijuana, and a controlled substance. After an investigation, the male was placed under arrest and is facing charges of Underage Possession of Alcohol, Possession of Marijuana and Possession of a Controlled Substance in Rocky River Municipal Court.

On January 20, at 11:23am a Bay Village resident arrived on station to report that she may be the victim of a scam. The Lake Road resident reported that she posted an advertisement for two cemetery plots at a business. She began trading emails with an interested party, who sent her a check for many times the original requested price. The scam artist stated that she should deposit the check and they would settle up for the remaining funds. The homeowner became suspicious and did not cash the check. She was advised of the scam and is not out any money.

On January 24, at 10:34am, Bay Village Police were dispatched to the lobby of the station to take a report of a motorist passing a stopped school bus. The operator of the bus told police that a gray Toyota passed his school bus as he was picking

up children on Wolf Road, east of Columbia Road. Further, the bus was equipped with a camera and that there was footage of the incident. After the video was viewed, police responded to a Bay Village resident's home and spoke with the alleged operator. The male admitted that he passed the bus and that he was not from Ohio and was unsure of the laws. He was cited and is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.
