On February 27, 2020 at 9:10am, Bay Village Police were dispatched to the area of Dover Junction Plaza on report of a suspicious group of people running around the area in dark clothing. Police investigated and found that the group was a local running club that would park in the lot, exercise and then stop for coffee.

On February 28, 2020, at 7:41am, Bay Village Police were dispatched to the intersection of Douglas Road and East Oviatt Road on complaint of vehicles not coming to a complete stop at the intersection. Police monitored the area and were able to stop numerous drivers and instruct them in the proper method of coming to a complete stop at a stop sign. Residents are encouraged to call police when they notice a problem intersection. Police will be dispatched to assist.

On February 28, 2020 at 11:39pm, Bay Village Police stopped a vehicle on Wolf Road at Forestview Road for a moving traffic violation. Police spoke with the male operator, a 40-year-old Brooklyn resident who appeared to be under the influence of alcohol. The male failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the male refused to submit to a breath test to measure his blood alcohol content. The male is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.

On February 29, at 12:06am, Bay Village Police stopped a vehicle on Wolf Road at Clague Road for a moving traffic violation. Police spoke with the male operator, a 29-year-old Cleveland resident who appeared to be under the influence of alcohol. The male failed field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. On station, the male provided a breath sample which showed a .086 blood alcohol content. The male is facing charges in Rocky River Municipal Court.
